

# 2007 Cultural Grants Approved by the Minister for the Arts

## Introduction

In its Cultural Grants Program the NSW Government, through Arts NSW, distributes funds of more than \$29 million to visual arts and craft, theatre, dance, music, literature and history, performing arts touring and capital infrastructure, the Western Sydney Arts Strategy and community cultural development for the State.

The program complements funding to the Sydney Festival and Sydney Writer's Festival, the major performing arts companies - Australian Brandenburg Orchestra, Australian Chamber Orchestra, Bangarra Dance Theatre, Bell Shakespeare, Company B, Musica Viva, Opera Australia, Sydney Dance Company, Sydney Symphony, Sydney Theatre Company and the Australian Ballet - and major cultural institutions including the Museum of Contemporary Arts, Sydney Opera House, Australian Museum, Powerhouse Museum, State Library of NSW, NSW Film and Television Office and Art Gallery of NSW.

The 2007 Cultural Grants Program for NSW includes funding *in excess of*:

- \$4.2 million for Visual Arts and Craft
- \$2.9 million for Theatre
- \$1.65 million for Capital Infrastructure
- \$1 million for Dance
- \$1.6 million for Music
- \$1.6 million for Museums

- **Theatre** - physical theatre and circus flourish, especially in regional areas

- **Dance** - international and national artists take part in Critical Path, NSW's choreographic 'lab'
- **Music** - all ages drugs and alcohol free events across the state, thanks to Music NSW and Indent
- **Museums** - *A Case for the Future* , a major study for Museums and Galleries NSW
- **Literature and History** - a network of Writers' Centres
- **Performing Arts Touring** - the Critical Stages program creates new touring networks, bringing shows to Brewarrina, Narromine, Bowraville, Bangalow and Walgett for the first time.
- **Capital Infrastructure** - funding for new cultural facilities in Dubbo, Albury, Tweed , Parramatta and Willoughby
- **Western Sydney Arts Strategy** - support for professional arts practice in Western Sydney through both program and artist development - **Community Cultural Development** - \$300,000 for BIG hART and \$235,000 for Accessible Arts
